## **Pre-Kindergarten Teaching Assistant**

Our next Teaching Assistant will support teachers, assist with learning groups at the direction of the teachers, provide supervision on the playground and at lunch, occasionally cover the whole class as needed for the teacher to attend meetings, prepping materials, and assist in classroom activities. This candidate will also be responsible for the after care program until 6 p.m. daily, supervising up to 12 students in a semi structured environment.

### **Requirements**

The successful candidate will have the following attributes:

- 12 ECE credits at community college or university level.
- Success working with children in a classroom setting
- Patience, kindness, and an overtly warm manner with children
- Ability to support the social-emotional growth of students and support problem-solving and conflict resolution
- Ability to assist in a learning group or activity with direction from the classroom teacher
- Confidence taking over whole class activities on occasion with a lesson plan from the teacher

School requirements (background check, first Aid/CPR (school sponsored) negative TB result.

The hours for this position are Monday through Friday 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
