



Garden Supervisor

Sacramento Country Day School, the regional leader in Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grade independent school education since 1964, seeks a part-time Garden Supervisor for our garden program.

The Sacramento Country Day Garden Supervisor works with faculty, staff and students to support and implement the school garden program activities and its overall maintenance. The Garden Supervisor will collaborate with Pre-K through 8th grade teachers and students to teach garden lessons that include all aspects of a productive gardening program.

Primary functions for the Garden Supervisor:

- Maintaining healthy soil
- Prepping rows
- Sowing seeds
- Transplanting
- Harvesting
- Preparing garden produce for eating

Additional duties include overall maintenance of the garden which involves weeding, maintaining compost piles, groundskeeping/landscaping, tree trimming, irrigation repair as needed, and tool maintenance. The Country Day garden covers one-third of an acre that includes the following components:

- Crop rows
- Food Bank rows
- Strawberry and Pumpkin patches
- Three Sisters Garden
- Native plant habitats
- Apple tree
- Almond tree
- Composting bins
- A greenhouse

Requirements

The hours range from 7-12 hours per week. This position requires a moderate to high level of physical activity. There is a possibility of chaperoning a local field trip in the future.

School requirements include: Background check, First Aid/CPR training (school sponsored), negative TB result.
