

Middle/High School Counselor

The Counselor will work with students, teachers, parents and the HS/MS School Heads to deliver a counseling program to MS/HS school students that includes delivering individual counseling meetings with HS students, small group lessons and making referrals to and communicating with outside therapists.

Requirements

The successful candidate will have the following attributes:

- A Bachelor's or higher degree in School Counseling, Child Psychology or related field
- Three years of experience working in a school setting
- Experience with school age students plus ability to support the school mission in all aspects of the counseling experience
- Communicating with families the needs of the student and providing outside resources as needed.
- Ability to apply effective interventions to classrooms and individual student behavior
- Serving on the Student Support Team
- Provide consultation and support for teachers as necessary
- Collaborate with other counselors and learning specialists at school and off campus as necessary
- Deliver SEL lessons individually, in small groups, or whole class settings

- In consultation with a child's therapist, Learning Specialist, and a child's teachers, create and implement an emotional support plan and distribute it to appropriate personnel

School requirements include: Background check, First Aid/CPR training (school sponsored), negative TB result.

This position is full time. Work hours are Monday - Friday - 8:00am - 4:00pm.
