## HOW WE ORGANIZE OURSELVES

Central Idea: *'A community is made up of people with different roles who work together to help each other'*

Conceptual Understanding and Lines of Inquiry:

- FORM: Who are the members of our classroom and our school community?
- FUNCTION: What are the different jobs that people do?
- CONNECTION: How do community helpers work together?

## WHERE WE ARE IN TIME AND PLACE

Central Idea: *'People live differently'*

Conceptual Understanding and Lines of Inquiry:

- FORM: What do homes around the world look like? What are the similarities and differences between these homes?
- FUNCTION: How are all kinds of homes built?
- CAUSATION: Why are homes built the way they are in different parts of the world?

## HOW THE WORLD WORKS

Central Idea: *'Transportation Systems enable people and communities to connect'*

Conceptual Understanding and Lines of Inquiry:

- FORM: What are the different types of air, water and land transportation?
- CONNECTION: How do transportation systems help communities access what they need?
- CHANGE: How have cars, ships, trains, planes etc evolved through the years?

## SHARING THE PLANET

Central Idea: *'We share the planet with animals that look and live differently'*

Conceptual Understanding and Lines of Inquiry:

- FORM: What do animals look like and what features can we identify, describe and classify?
- CONNECTION: How do our actions, good or bad, affect the animals we share our planet with?
- RESPONSIBILITY: What small things can we do to help protect our animal friends?
